

Endeavor Charter School Admissions Information and Lottery Procedure

Admission Requirements: The ECS is open to all District students in grades 9-12 for voluntary application and enrollment. Students in grade 12 will be admitted if they have successfully completed a previous year at ECS. All applications and enrollments shall be voluntary. An application and constructed response questions are required as part of the admissions process.

Admissions Lottery: Provided the number of applications received during the enrollment window does not exceed the enrollment cap, all applicants will be accepted for admission. Following the enrollment deadline, additional students will be accepted up to the enrollment cap on a first-come, first-serve basis.

However, if the number of applications received during the enrollment period exceeds the enrollment cap, and the Governance Board decides not to increase the cap to accommodate the applicants, the applicants will make up the lottery pool. A random selection from the lottery pool will be made to ensure equal access without regard to demographic information. The Governance Board will oversee the lottery and it will become a matter of school record. Students who were not accepted by the lottery will be placed on a priority waiting list in the order drawn. Students requesting admittance after the lottery will be placed at the end of that waiting list, in the order in which they apply. Students will be notified of openings in the order established by the waiting list should they arise.

An automatic enrollment preference shall be extended to siblings of students currently enrolled in the school, siblings of school alumni, children of founding members, and children of teaching staff working in Endeavor Charter School.
